UNIFORM POLICY

McAuley College delivers a holistic education for our students. As part of this learning, our Uniform Policy is designed to promote respect of self, others and the community through the implementation of expectations around presentation and the wearing of the College Uniform.

Students are expected to wear the formal uniform when attending school, travelling to and from school and on special occasions. Neatness, tidiness and cleanliness of the uniform are essential and no variations are acceptable. Any attire worn under the uniform must not be visible.

Students will be required to change into their Sports Uniform for HPE lessons. Only for designated Sports Days such as Interhouse Carnivals or Interschool Sports days (such as SECA), will students be permitted to wear their Sports Uniform to and from school.

Formal Uniform	<p>SKIRT: College mid length skirt with front box pleats – Navy <i>(Length should be to knee level)</i></p> <p>BLOUSE: College navy and white pinstripe blouse with collar and orange trim School logo embroidered on left side</p> <p>TIE: College navy tie (short) with orange trim</p> <p>HAT: College navy formal hat with embroidered band</p> <p>SHOES: Black leather lace up shoes with regulation heel (Refer to examples given by School Locker)</p> <p>NO sneakers or sports shoes.</p> <p>SOCKS: College white sockette</p> <p>Black stockings / tights can be worn during winter months <i>(Not available at the Uniform Shop)</i></p>	<p>SHORTS: College mid length shorts – Navy <i>(No belt required)</i></p> <p>SHIRT: College navy and white pinstripe shirt with collar and orange trim - School logo embroidered on pocket</p> <p>TIE: No tie</p> <p>HAT: College navy formal hat with 'McAuley College' band</p> <p>SHOES: Black leather lace up shoes with regulation heel (Refer to examples given by School Locker)</p> <p>NO sneakers or sports shoes.</p> <p>SOCKS: College white sockette</p>
Blazer (Optional – to be worn with Formal Uniform only)	College Blazer with College Logo embroidered on left side available as winter option and/or for formal occasions. It is not compulsory for students in the Junior years.

Sports Uniform	<p>SHORTS: College embroidered navy shorts <i>(Only regulation College shorts acceptable. No other brands allowed.)</i></p> <p>POLO SHIRT: College navy collared polo shirt with orange panels and white piping – School logo embroidered on left side</p> <p>HAT: College navy Bucket hat with the College logo embroidered on the front</p> <p>SHOES: Predominately white joggers providing adequate support for Sport activities. Shoe laces must be white.</p> <p>SOCKS: College white sockette</p>	
Tracksuit	<p>A College Tracksuit will be available for winter. It is only to be worn as an alternative to the College Sports Uniform.</p> <p>JACKET: College navy tracksuit jacket with orange panels and trim, with white piping. College Logo embroidered on left side.</p> <p>PANTS: College navy tracksuit pants with orange panels and white trim.</p>	
Jumper (Worn with both Formal and Sports Uniform)	College poly-cotton knit navy pullover with College Logo embroidered	
Bag	College school Bag – Navy backpack with College logo	
Swimming Togs (No school togs)	Standard one-piece costume where modesty is essential. To support Sun Safe practices, a Sun Shirt is required for lessons held during the day and outdoors.	Standard speedos or board shorts. To support Sun Safe practices, a Sun Shirt is required for lessons held during the day, outdoors.

Other Uniform regulations related to grooming...		
Hair	<p>Hair should be well groomed and of a single natural colour. Extreme hairstyles and colours are not acceptable. Shoulder length hair should be tied back at all times.</p> <p>Ribbons and hair accessories must be in school colours of navy and orange. A small range of hair accessories can be purchased from the Canteen.</p>	<p>Hair should be well groomed and of a single natural colour. Extreme hairstyles and colours are not acceptable. Long hair is NOT permitted. Fringes should be kept short and out of eyes.</p> <p>All boys should be clean shaven at all times. Beards, goatees, moustaches or long side burns are not permitted.</p>
Jewellery	<p>One pair of small gold/silver studs or sleepers are permitted in the earlobes.</p> <p>A Christian religious symbol on a chain (small and discreet) is permitted.</p> <p>A conservative wrist watch is permitted.</p> <p>Facial and body piercings, stretchers and any other jewellery are not permitted.</p>	<p>A Christian religious symbol on a chain is permitted.</p> <p>A conservative wrist watch is permitted.</p> <p>Facial and body piercings, stretchers and any other jewellery are not permitted.</p>
Make-up	<p>No nail polish or make-up is to be worn. No acrylic or gel nails.</p>	
Other	<p>Tattoos / henna and unnatural coloured contact lenses are not permitted. No chewing gum permitted on College grounds.</p>
