

McAuley College, Beaudesert Enrolment Policy

POLICY

When enrolling students, McAuley College gives priority to baptised Catholics. The College also enrols students from other faith traditions whose families demonstrate that they share the expressed values of the College and who are willing to support and contribute to the college's vision and ethos.

RATIONALE

This policy provides direction and assistance to McAuley College in the formulation of just and equitable enrolment procedures.

COMMITMENT

The College seeks to enter into partnership with students and parents by supporting and encouraging all students to become successful learners, confident and creative individuals and active and informed citizens who will contribute positively to their faith community and society.

ENROLMENT PROCESS

1. Enrolment at McAuley College is subject to an interview with a member of the College Senior Leadership Team and to the availability of vacancies within the College. Decisions regarding enrolment will take into account the number of vacancies, the needs of students and any exceptional circumstances.

McAuley College welcomes the enrolments of students from families that share the expressed values of the College and who are willing to support and contribute to the College's vision and ethos. However, where demands for enrolment exceeds capacity, priority for enrolment is as follows:

- students who are baptised Catholics and who attend a Catholic school
- students enrolled at St Mary's Primary School, Beaudesert and All Saints' School, Boonah
- students who are baptised Catholic and attend other primary schools
- students from other faith traditions who demonstrate that they share the expressed values of the College and who are willing to support and contribute to the College's vision and ethos
- 2. Enrolment of students who may require special provisions for their educational placement, will be considered in accordance with the Brisbane Catholic Education's *Enrolment Application and Support Procedures for Students Requiring Significant Educational Adjustments*. This additional enrolment application support process will gauge the level of support required, prior to confirmed acceptance of enrolment.
- 3. The final decision regarding offers of enrolment is at the discretion of the Principal.
- 4. This policy will be reviewed at regular intervals, as required.
