

## **McAuley College, Beaudesert**

**UNIFORM POLICY** 

The McAuley College Uniform was developed initially in 2016 by the College Steering Committee, and subsequently reviewed in October 2019 by the College Uniform Development Committee. The latter was done with reference to the principles outlined in the Brisbane Catholic Education School Uniform Policy; and in consultation with parents, staff and students.

McAuley College sets high expectations for all students with regards to the wearing of the College uniform. The school uniform increases a sense of belonging and engagement, promotes health and safety and encourages respect of self, others and community.

Students are expected to wear the formal uniform when attending school, traveling to and from school and on special occasions. Neatness, tidiness and cleanliness of the uniform are essential, and no variations are acceptable. Any attire worn under the uniform must not be visible.

Students wear their Sports Uniform every Thursday to and from school to coincide with our Sports Program. Otherwise, students are required to change into their Sports Uniform for HPE lessons.

Blazer (Optional for Junior Years– to be worn with Formal Uniform only)	College Blazer with College Logo embroidered on left side available as winter option and/or for formal occasions. It is not compulsory for students in the Junior years.			
Sports Uniform	SHORTS: College embroidered navy shorts (Only regulation College shorts acceptable. No other brands allowed.)			
	POLO SHIRT: College navy collared polo shirt with orange panels and white piping – School logo embroidered on left side			
	HAT: College navy Bucket hat with the College logo embroidered on the front			
	SHOES: Predominately white joggers providing adequate support for Sport activities. Shoelaces must be white.			
	SOCKS: College white sockette			
	A College Cap and College Bike Pants are available for students to wear for specific sporting events, as directed by the College.			
Tracksuit	A College Tracksuit will be available for winter. It is only to be worn as an alternative to the College Sports Uniform.			
	JACKET: College navy tracksuit jacket with orange panels and trim, with white piping. College Logo embroidered on left side. The tracksuit jacket can only be worn with the Sports uniform.			
	PANTS: College navy tracksuit pants with orange panels and white trim.			
Jumper (Worn with both Formal and Sports Uniform)	College poly-cotton knit navy pullover with College Logo embroidered			
Scarf	College scarf – Navy with double orange stripes			
Bag	College school Bag – Navy backpack with College logo			
College Satchel	Navy draw string satchel with College logo for students to use as an additional carry bag for Sports gear or to be taken on school excursions as an alternate to the larger school bag.			
Swimming Togs (No school togs)	Standard one-piece costume where modesty is essential. To support Sun Safe practices, a Sun Shirt is required for lessons held during the day and outdoors. Hair	Hair should be well groomed and of a single natural colour. Extreme hairstyles and colours are not acceptable. Shoulder length hair should be tied back at all times. 	Ribbons and hair accessories must be in school colours of navy and orange. A small range of hair accessories can be purchased from the Canteen.	All boys should be clean shaven at all times. Beards, goatees, moustaches or long sideburns are not permitted.		
Jewellery	One pair of small gold/silver studs or sleepers are permitted in the earlobes. No clear earrings.	No earrings.		
	A Christian religious symbol on a chain (small and discreet) is permitted.	A Christian religious symbol on a chain is permitted.		
	A conservative wristwatch is permitted.	A conservative wristwatch is permitted.

Make-up	No nail polish or make-up is to be worn. This includes tinted moisturiser, tinted sunscreen and BB cream, as some examples. No acrylic or gel nails.			
Other	Tattoos / henna and unnatural coloured contact lenses are not permitted. No chewing gum permitted on College grounds.
