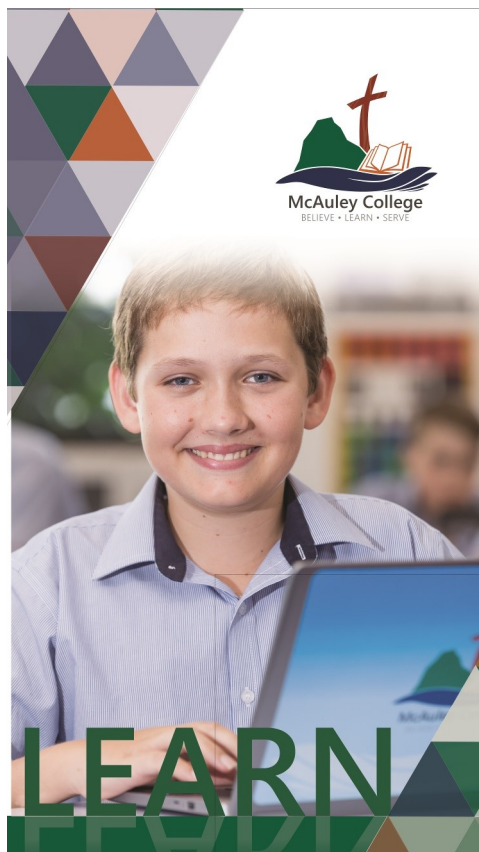
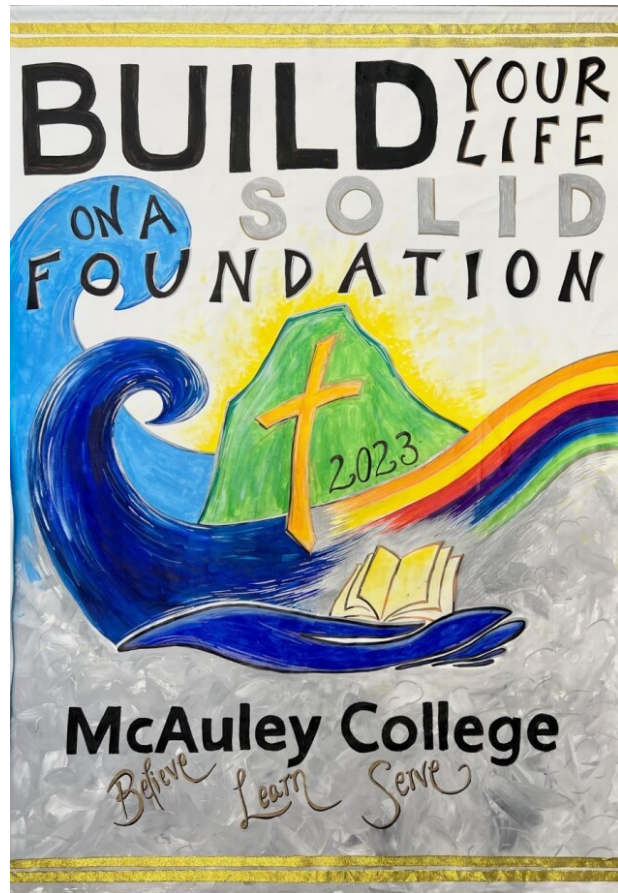
Attended the Australasian Mercy Secondary Schools Association Conference (AMSSA) in Brisbane.
