Term / Year	Activity	Focus	Outcomes for students
Year 7 & 8 (and beyond)	Setting goals at the start of each term		
Year 7 LEARN DAY	University Visit Elevate presentation on Study Skills	Provide students with an experience of universities... to open their vision for their future and provide stimulus for then to be inspirational. Use of Elevate to explicitly teach study	Opportunities opened for future linked to going to university. Develop study skills
Year 9 (Term 2)	“My Path” Interview following LEARN Day (with completion of My Futures survey)	Introduce students and their parents to possible pathways; documenting their interests, strengths, and goals prior to Year 10.	Students become familiar with online career tools; review their academic goals and are these aligned with their current performance and work practices; and look at pathway options at school and beyond.
Year 9 LEARN DAY (Term 2)	Elevate presentation on Memory My Future survey	Develop skills relevant to success in senior years, especially around the recollection of work across the two years of study. My Future survey starts to get students to think about their strengths and interest, and these may shape possible future careers options.	Build memory skills Consider possible pathways / Motivate application to study.
Year 10 Work Experience (Term 2)	Work Experience (4 days)	Explore a possible field of work to be career informing.	Understanding of possible work and future career option.
